- Airport/Airfield construction report presented by Deanna Stoddard.
- Airport Master Plan ALP and Exhibit A are being circulated for signature.
- Taxiway Bravo Rehabilitation Schedule II Construction FAA AIP/Discretionary grant received and executed.
- Taxiway Alpha Realignment 100% design received. Construction postponed until 2025.
- Concourse Modernization Permit set for first construction package submitted to PPRBD. GMP for Package A received and is under negotiation.

- RAC Parking Lot Rehab Design Executing GMP; NTP will be issued shortly. Kickoff meeting June 29, 2023.
- Inline Baggage System TSA OTA received; OTA and Task Order executed. Kickoff meeting scheduled for later in June.

• Traffic Trend Report

- The airline data analysis was presented by Joe Nevill.
- Colorado Springs Airport (COS) welcomed a total 190,233 travelers through the airport last month.
- In the month of May, COS enplaned 94,906 passengers, which is a decrease of 2.8 percent from the same time last year.
- Average passenger load factor at COS was 84.5 percent, 3.8 percentage points higher year-over-year.
- Year-to-date, load factor has averaged 78.6 percent, while summer load factors are expected to exceed 80 percent.
- Effective July 11, Southwest Airlines will begin service to Long Beach (LGB).
- Transportation Security Administration (TSA) throughputs were up 15 percent year over year.
